Task Scheduler is a Windows® job scheduler program that allows a user to generate and oversee tasks that the computer automatically operates at times and dates that were specified from creating a task. Tasks created are used for the 920i® / 1280 Enterprise™ Series Indicators utilizing .DEJ files created from the Interchange Database Management System.

How to Schedule Tasks

Associate the .DEJ file to open with the Interchange program.

- 1. Right-Click the desktop shortcut for the .DEJ file and click Properties.
- 2. Copy the Target Path.
