Contents: Configuring SLP-5 to Automatically Populate Uni-9 Presets



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Background

When working with Uni-9 preset keyboards, it is possible to create a preset keyboard template in SLP-5. Then, every time PLUs are added/edited/deleted, the preset keyboard updates automatically.

Procedure

- Before beginning this procedure, determine the categories to be used. Assign a numeric value to each category starting with 2. The list and numbering will be used later to create the preset keyboard template.
- 2. Open the SLP-5 Setup Utility and login as an Administrator.




Figure 1. Select "PLU Fields".

- 3. Go to PLU Fields. See Figure 1.




Figure 2. Select "Advanced Settings".

4. Click on the **Advanced Settings** icon. See Figure 2.




Figure 3. Select and Edit "Preset Group".

Select Preset Group and then click the Edit icon. See Figure 3.




Figure 4. Add the Preset Groups Created in Step 1.

- 6. Confirm "Enable?" and "Display in Edit Screen?" are checked. See Figure 4.
- 7. Add the groups based on the category list created in step 1.

- 8. Click **OK** and close the Setup Utility.
- 9. Open SLP-5 and login as an Administrator.
- 10. Go to UNI-9/WM-AI Presets and create a new Uni-9 preset keyboard.




Figure 5. Select "Default Key Layout".

- 11. Click the **Default Key Layout** icon. See Figure 5.




Figure 6. Enter the Properties for Each Jump Group (Category).

- 12. Create a new key for a category. Set the Key Data value and Key Text to match the category list created in step 1. See Figure 6.
 - a. Uncheck the "Available to automated key layout configuration?" option. This is required to add a Jump Group (category) key.
 - b. Key Type = Jump Group
 - c. Key Data = 2 (this is for the first category only)
- 13. Repeat step 12 to create Jump Group keys for all categories 3, 4, 5, etc. created in step 1.




Figure 7. Add to the Group List.

14. In the Group list in the lower right corner, add the first group from the list of categories created in step 1. <u>Do not</u> add the remaining groups at this time. See Figure 7.

Notes: • The first group "Preset Key Group 1" is the main page where the category keys reside. Rename that group page as "Main".

 If a group is added but no PLU preset keys are created, the group will not be saved.




Figure 8. Preset PLU Keys to Be Populated Automatically.

- 15. Next, select the group added in the Group box and design the PLU preset key layout for that group. See Figure 8.
- 16. Add as many preset PLU keys as desired.
 - a. Make sure "Available to Automated Key Layout Configuration" is checked. See the lower left of Figure 6.
 - b. Key Type = PLU. Only PLU keys are available on this page.
 - c. Select the font size. Font sizes 10 or 11 generally work well depending on the key size.
 - d. Select the Upper Background and Upper Text colors for the key.
 - e. To add keys, right the last key added and choose Copy. Then right click and Paste. Crtl+C (copy) and Ctrl+V (paste) are also available.

- 17. Click the **Return Arrow** to save the changes. **DO NOT** click the "X" at the upper right to exit. SLP-5 will abandon the changes if the "X" is clicked even if the **Save** icon had been clicked.
- 18. Go to Add/Modify/Delete PLUs.




Figure 9. Assign PLUs to a Preset Group.

- 19. Add PLUs and then select which group they belong to in the **Preset Group** field. For existing PLUs select the appropriate **Preset Group**. See Figure 9.

- Return to the UNI-9/WM-AI Presets and select the keyboard that was created.




Figure 10. PLUs Automatically Assigned to the Preset Keys.

- 21. Check the "Enable Automated Key Layout Configuration" option. See Figure 10.
- 22. PLUs will be assigned to the preset keys starting with the lowest PLU number.

- 23. Verify the PLU presets populate as expected. If not, return to the Default Key Layout and edit the key sizes, fonts, etc. as needed.
- 24. If changes are made to the Default Key Layout, check and uncheck the "Enable Automated Key Layout Configuration" option to repopulate the preset keys.
- 25. After the first category "2" is complete repeat from step 14 for the remaining categories one at a time.
- 26. To stop automatically populating the PLU preset keys and edit as usual, uncheck the "Enable Automated Key Layout Configuration" option. Be aware that reenabling the automated keys will overwrite all manual edits.



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
