

Operator Card – 682 Digital Weight Indicator Livestock Weighing Quick Start

This quick start guide is for use by service technicians and scale users of the 682 Digital Weight Indicator. These instructions explain how to configure and use the 682 indicator's AG/Livestock Weighing functions.

Power the Scale

Press  to turn the indicator on or off.

Enter Shrink

The shrink value is applied to the gross weight and is limited to 0.0-99.0%.

1. Press the **Shrink** softkey.
2. Enter shrink value, using the on-screen or physical keypad.
3. Press **Save**.

Clear Shrink

Press the Clear Shrink softkey to default the shrink value to zero.



NOTE: Entered shrink value persists unless new value is entered, Clear Shrink key is pressed, or power is cycled.




Figure 1. 682 Indicator

Head Count

1. Load the first group of animals onto the scale.
2. Press **Count Average** softkey.
3. Enter head count value, using on-screen or physical keypad.
4. Press **Save**. The count average format prints. Count and weight save to the accumulator for load totaling.
5. Repeat Step 3 through Step 4 for each group included in the load.



NOTE: Indicator must return to zero to allow rearm load total accumulation.

Load Total

1. Press the > softkey to display the **Print Accumulator** and **Clear Accumulator** softkeys.

2. Press the **Print Accumulator** softkey to print load total.
-  **NOTE:** To reprint the load total, repeat this step for each additional load total ticket.
3. Press the **Clear Accumulator** softkey to reset accumulator data.
-  **NOTE:** Press the **Print** key on the indicator keypad for a standard weight only ticket (no accumulation or shrink factor).
