The Statement of Accuracy provides just such a document when and where traceability to NIST, the need for an ISO/IEC 17025 accredited certificate of calibration is not a concern. The Statement of Accuracy is the least comprehensive documentation offered by Rice Lake Weighing Systems. Check your internal policies and procedures to determine what type of documentation you require and thoroughly review the Certificate of Weight Calibration, accredited and non-accredited, options prior to selecting laboratory documentation.

The Statement of Accuracy includes the following information:

- 1 Name and address of the company that adjusted the weights
- 2 Part number
- 3 Description/Serial number
- 4 Maximum permissible error for the specific accuracy class
- 5 Name and address of company that items were sold to
- 6 Name and address of company that items are shipped to
- *Only applicable to new weights. Not a Legal for Trade or traceable document.
