1280 Enterprise[™] Series 2020 Date Entry Workaround

Product: 1280 Enterprise Series indicator with firmware prior to version 2.00Issue: Date cannot be set to a value after December 31, 2019 (123119)Solution: Enter a 2019 date, then edit the date to 2020

If the date is invalid and a new date needs to be entered (i.e. when a battery is first installed or a unit has been defaulted), the firmware does not allow the date to be initially set to a value after December 31, 2019 (123119).

The workaround is to set the date to a valid 2019 date first (e.g. 042419), and then edit it to the current date (e.g. 042420).

Note This date entry issue has only existed since the calendar year 2020 and has been addressed in firmware version 2.00.
