Product: Ishida Astra, retail price computing scale

Issue: <u>"Memory Full" message when receiving data from AstraLink PC program</u>

Cause: <u>Selection of "Overwrite existing Astra data" when sending data</u>

Solution: <u>Turn off "Deletion command supported" in AstraLink setup</u>

Follow the steps below to recover from the "Memory Full" problem.

- 1. In AstraLink, go to menus Setup and Comms Setup and uncheck "Deletion command supported".
- Before resetting the Astra's memory, backup the scale data using AstraLink to receive ALL DATA from the Astra -- follow the AstraLink screen directions for receiving data from the Astra.
- 3. When prompted, save the received data in a <u>new database</u>.
- 4. Clear the Astra's memory.
 - a. Turn on the Astra while holding down the number 1 key.
 - b. Release the 1 key after two beeps.
 - c. Press 2, ENTER.
 - d. Press ZERO twice.
 - e. After the Astra displays PASS, press END and turn off the power.
- 5. Use AstraLink to send ALL DATA from the <u>new database</u> back to the Astra -- follow the AstraLink screen directions for sending ALL DATA to the Astra.
- 6. Review the <u>new database</u> files listed below. The information in these files will be current but may be incomplete or partially corrupted.

Store Name & Address PLU File Keyboard Presets Extra Messages Nutrition File (if enabled)

If information is bad or missing, open the <u>original database</u> and send ONLY the data files that are needed.

7. Once the Astra is fully loaded, repeat step 1 above to create a new and complete database. Use the new database from this point forward.
