## Mobile Ag Weigh Center Software User Guide



## Scope

A USB 920i with custom programming will be interfaced to a trailer scale, inclinometer, and a TM-U295 ticket printer and allows the operator to weigh animals and store the total weight, head count, individual gross weight, shrink factor, and time/date. All transactions are stored locally on the 920i and can be retrieved using a USB flash drive or Interchange PC software (if directly connected to PC).

**After a successful download the 920i needs to be power cycled.**

## Sequence of Operation

System displays the [Weigh Animals] – [Shrink %] – [Batch Complete] – [Reprint] – [Setup] softkeys when it powers up or when it exits the configuration or setup menus.

### Weighing Animals (Mobile 129998)

1. Turn on the indicator by pressing the power switch and insert a ticket into the printer. Press *FORWARD* on printer to secure the paper. *If paper will not go into the printer under the print head, make sure the release light is on. If it is not, press the RELEASE button on the printer.*
2. Verify the scale is level. If it is not, it will blank the weigh display screen and go to a screen showing the current pitch and roll.
3. Press **ZERO** to re-zero the scale (if required).
4. Load the animals onto the scale. *Animals moving around could cause the scale to become out of level. An Out of Level prompt will display momentarily until animals settle down, if it goes off within five seconds it's ignored.*
5. Press [Weigh Animals] softkey.
6. The indicator will prompt – “Enter Head Count”. Using the keypad, enter the number of animals to be weighed and press **ENTER**. System captures a stable gross weight. If verify head count is turned on the indicator will prompt – “Re-Key in Head Count”. Using the keypad, enter the number of animals to be weighed and press **ENTER**. Head count, total weight and average weight per head will be displayed. A line (ticket) will print out with the animal count, weight, units and average weight to the TM-U295 printer. Typically, when using verify head count the operator will remove the cattle before entering the head count the second time.

- Last Weighment — this provides information on the previous group of animals that were on the scale.
  - Current Weighment — this provides information on the number of animals currently on scale, their total weight and the average weight per animal.
  - Totals — this provides information on the total of all animals weighed in the current weigh batch and their average weight.
7. Unload the scale.
  8. To continue weighing animals, repeat steps 4-7 until all animals from the current batch have been weighed.
  9. Press [Batch Complete] to complete the current batch of animals. Summary information will be printed on the ticket and the ticket will be released.

**Last Ticket Reprint**

Press [**Reprint**] any time prior to starting the next batch to reprint the last ticket.

**Shrink**

Press [**Shrink %**] at any time to change the shrink percentage (0.0-99.99 percent) to be subtracted from the total gross weight. This is saved through power cycles.

The default is 0.0 percent.

**Weighing a Single Animal**

Press [**Weigh Animals**] softkey and enter a head count of 1.

Press [**Batch Complete**] to print the summary information on the ticket.

**Modifying the Database Tables**

A PC program called iNterchange can be used by the end-user to upload, export and clear the database tables. The exported file may be saved as a delimited text file, an Excel spreadsheet, or as a XML document. iRev is another option to do database maintenance.

**Application Setup & Configuration**

The [**Setup**] softkey is password-protected and offers access to the following:

- Display Program Name & Version
- Display a weight widget
